ROSE

MATERIALS: 10 g of pink yarn no. 30; crochet hook no. 22 (English no. 5, International no. 1.00); 70 cm (28 in.) of metal thread.

DIAMETER OF THE FLOWER: 8 cm (3 1/4 in.).

EXPLANATIONS: LARGE PETALS (5): On a base chain of 31 ch, make 2 times: (1 ch, 1 dc), 3 times (1 ch, 1 tr), 4 times (1 ch, 1 dc), 3 times (1 ch, 1 tr), 2 times (1 ch, 1 dc), 1 ch, 1 sl st. in the last ch of the base. **2nd-12th row:** Rep.: * 1 dc, 1 ch according to the drawing inc., then dec. To increase, hook 2 dc in the same hole or make 4 ch, and for the dec., join tog. 2 dc and proceed according to the drawing. Surround the petals with a round of sc and leave about 20 cm (7 3/4 in.) of yarn.

SMALL AND MEDIUM PETALS: Work according to the drawing on a base of 23 and 21 ch. Make 5 petals no. both sizes.

FLOWER BASE: 1st round: In a loop formed with the end of the yarn, make 5 ch, 17 dbl.tr. **2nd round:** Rep. 6 times: * 5 ch, 2 quad.tr, 1 picot of 3 ch, 2 quad.tr, 5 ch, 1 sc *

JOINING: Starch the petals and fold the edges toward the outside. First join 2 small petals with the metal thread placing them one on top of the other, then surround them with 3 other small petals passing the metal thread through the base of each petal. Proceed in the same way for the 5 medium and large petals. Pass all the metal yarns in the middle of the flower base, glue the latter, then wind the yarn around the metal thread which is curved into a ring. The beg. of the stem is attached in the flower base.
