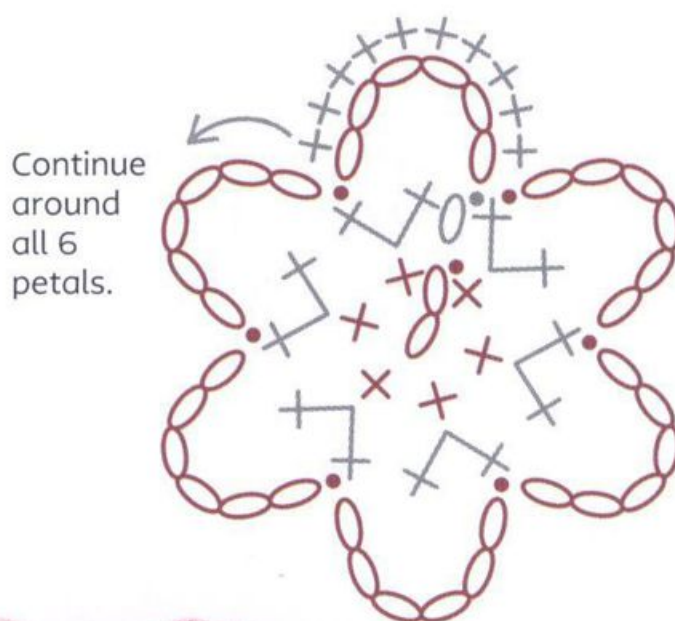


2 Anemone



Skill level: 

This flower is quick and easy to make, using only chains, single crochets, and slip stitches. It is simple enough to be the very first crochet project for a beginner, and is an excellent project for practicing your stitches.



Materials:


Fingering weight yarn in 2 colors:

-  Color A: 4 yds (3.75 m)
-  Color B: 4 yds (3.75 m)

Tools:

Hook size: D-3 (3.25 mm)
Yarn needle
Scissors

Chart key:

-  Ch Chain
-  Sl st Slip stitch
-  Sc Single crochet



Diam. of finished flower: 2½ in (6.5 cm)



Pattern

With Color A, ch 2 (see Step 1).

Rnd 1: 6 sc in 2nd ch. Join rnd with sl st (see Steps 1–2). (6 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc. Join rnd with sl st (see Steps 3–4). (12 sc)

Rnd 3: [Ch 6, skip next sc, sl st in next sc] six times (see Steps 5–6).

Fasten off Color A.

Attach Color B to any ch-6 loop.

Rnd 4: [10 sc in first ch-6 loop of prev rnd] six times (see Steps 7–8).

Join rnd with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off Color B. Weave in ends.



1 With Color A, ch 2. **Rnd 1:** 6 sc into the 2nd ch from the hook (as marked by the arrow).



2 Join the round with a sl st into the first sc of the round as marked by the arrow.



3 **Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in the first sc, 2 sc into each of the next 5 sc. Join the round with a sl st. (12 sc in the round).



4 When both rounds are completed, your flower will look like this.



5 **Rnd 3:** Ch 6, skip the next sc, then sl st into the next sc of Round 2 (refer to the arrow for the placement of the first sl st) to connect the petal.



6 Repeat Step 5 five more times to create six petals in total.



7 Attach Color B to the first loop of any of the ch-6 loops in Round 3. Ch 1. **Rnd 4:** Work 10 sc evenly along the first ch-6 loop.

8 Continue crocheting 10 sc into each ch-6 loop. Finish the round with a sl st into the first sc of the round. Fasten off Color B.
