

Instructions:

All cross stitching is done with two strands of floss.

⊙ Indicates French knot. Use one strand of 335 and wrap twice.

Rhodes stitch is stitched with one strand of 744.

“Cupcakes” is backstitched with two strands of 3712.

Small cherry stem is backstitched with one strand of 988.

Large cherry stem is backstitched with two strands of 988.

Backstitching around cupcake frosting is stitched with one strand of 842.

For eyelet stitches, use one strand of 988 and one strand of 722. Alternate colors for each eyelet.

After stitching is completed, press out any hoop marks. Without using hoop, stitch beads on cupcake using beading needle. Alternate using 02012 and 02004.

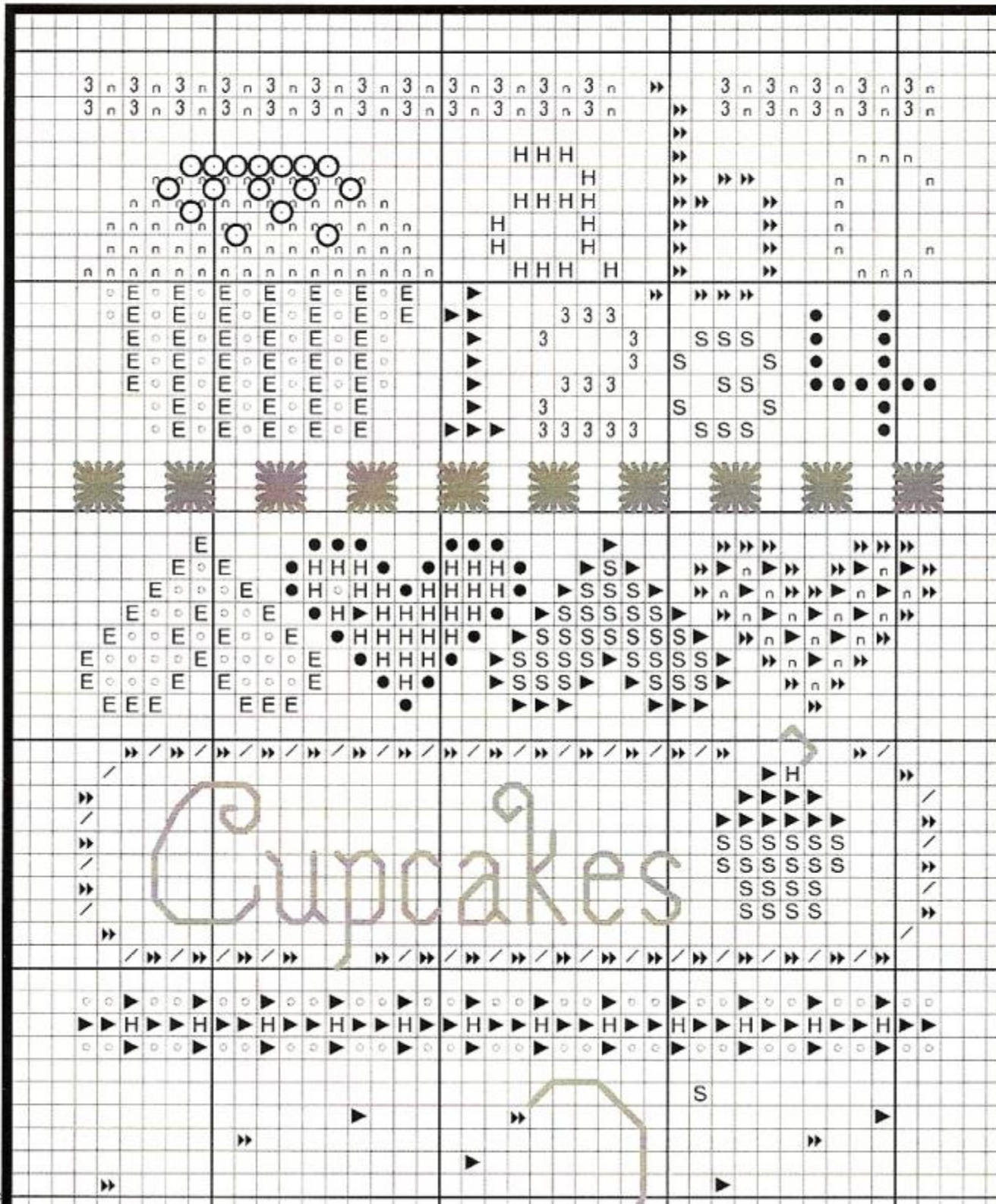
