Make a... patch card

Step 1

FOLD your card in half widthways then open out so you can stitch the design on to the front.

Step 2

TRIM your stitching to 11.5x9cm then stitch to the centre of the front of your card by machine. Remove a few fabric threads for a frayed effect.
